

TO BAN SUPREME COURT PACKING



"The Supreme Court of the United States Shall Be Composed of Nine Justices"

A bipartisan citizens movement can preserve an **Independent Supreme Court** for future generations!

COURT PACKING WOULD BE A DISASTER FOR AMERICA.

THE "KEEP NINE" AMENDMENT WOULD BAN IT!

- Court packing would be a law passed by Congress to increase the number of Supreme Court Justices so the Court would do more of what Congress wants.
- Court packing would make the Supreme Court a virtual puppet of politicians in Washington.
- It would weaken checks and balances on the abuse of power by a future President or Congress.
- It would undermine the respect for the rule of law that protects our Constitutional rights and freedoms.
- It would weaken the ability of the Court to resolve divisive issues in ways that are accepted by all.

For more than 150 years an independent Supreme Court has protected our Constitutional rights.

Now it is time to permanently end the threat of Court packing by persuading Congress to propose and states to ratify the "Keep Nine" Amendment!

THE "KEEP NINE" AMENDMENT:

- Permanently preserves the current number of 9 Supreme Court Justices.
- Protects the independence of the Court from any attempt by Congress to increase or decrease its size.



The bipartisan "Keep Nine" Amendment was first introduced by a Democrat in the U.S. House and a Republican in the U.S. Senate.

Just as pressure from voters and states forced Congress to propose Amendments for a Woman's Right to Vote, and Presidential Term Limits, similar pressure can force Congress to propose and states to ratify the "Keep Nine" Amendment.

GROWING SUPPORT FOR "KEEP NINE"

- Polling shows that votes would favor the "Keep Nine" Amendment by a 3-1 margin!
- More than 200 Members of Congress and 800 state legislators now support the "Keep Nine" Amendment.
- 19 State Legislative Chambers have passed Resolutions urging Congress to propose the "Keep Nine" Amendment.
- The "Keep Nine" Amendment is the most widely supported Supreme Court reform proposal in America!
